- 5) Staten Island is the borough least integrated of the city of New York.


The surface of New York is the 1.214 km² and the population is the 8.143.200 inhabitants

The Empire State Building is the most mythical building of New York City, high of 381 meters. He has 102 floors.




The Empire State Building has been built in 1931, 2 years later the Chrysler Building in 1929.
